Family is at the heart of a Knights Catholic life. Following in our families faith we are first baptised as children and go on to choose to receive the other sacraments and develop our Faith. As Knights, we seek to strengthen Family life through building involvement of our Members and families in the lives of their Parishes. Knights follow the doctrine of the Church and support pro-family and pro-life issues. We hold various family events including various Masses, local social events, quiz's, rosaries, annual raffles, pilgrimages, etc. We support the Widows of our members and pray regularly for deceased Brothers. We hold a bi-annual Mass in Liverpool in remembrance of deceased Knights and their families.

Knights arrange various fundraising events and social events throughout the year to help raise money for local good causes and centrally via our National Action Project.
