*As suggested in previous Bulletins the Closing Dates of the Prayer/Essay Competitions have been brought forward to allow presentation to be made to winners before the end of School year. It must be noted that Primary yr6/ yr7 pupils leave for Secondary School and Secondary School yr11,yr12,yr13/S5,S6 may leave after taking their GCSE for work, College or after A' Levels leave for University. This way at least the Presentation can be made before they depart to work or for further education.

My comments for January 2021 follows: Zoom Training - I am currently carrying out One-On-One Zoom training for a Council's Officers. After each Officers One-On-One Training he receives the Zoom recording and a Resource Folder of items from the Orders website plus a Role Guide note. Next the same Training Role is carried out with the whole Council on a different date, just before the Council monthly Committee Meeting. I consider this opportunity a privilege to be able to pass on the very little knowledge I have acquired onto others using the Order's publications with advisory notes. The Membership Officer now has a voice in Council. The Action and Youth Officer has disseminated all competitions to various Schools, Parishes. He is placing things on the Council Whatsapp page and before long will put items on the parish Facebook page. He has written the Parish Priest asking for space on the website and asking for support within the Parish. He has had a very, very positive response from the Parish Priest and been given website space. His promotion led to 6 Local Young People taking part in the Youth 2000 UK Online event that was emailed and placed on the Youth and Young People Facebook page. Furthermore, both Officers are now submitting written reports for each Council Meeting.

Dear WPGK, can I implore you to kindly communicate who your Youth Contact is to your Council Action and Youth OR Youth Officers? Can they know when or what date to send the Competitions in for Provincial Adjudication? Can they know how many of the entries to send in please for adjudication? Please, please do this in the advent the Provincial Role is vacant or about to become so. God Bless you.

- Can we scan our winners 1-3, 1-4 or Both year/age group winners entries at Council Level, scan by Council at Provincial Level scan by Provinces back to the Province of Councils whether Paintings, Essay or Prayer entries to all the Participating bodies i.e. Schools, Youth Clubs, Parish Priests etc? Do not display the names of the winners rather use e.g. First Place, Second Place, Third Place and so on....
