If you feel we could do something in a more productive way – please let us know. If there is something that drew you to the Order initially and you feel that we don't portray that enough – please let us know.


FAITH - FAMILY - FRATERNITY

SPIRITUALITY & WELFARE

As we start a new KSC year, we hope and pray for a brighter year, I understand that the majority of Brothers now have had at least one of their COVID 19 vaccinations, we have a lot of people to be grateful to for the organisation and the sheer logistics of vaccinating the whole of the UK, and we should be saying a prayer of thanks for them, many of our Brothers family have been working on the front line in the NHS, and other services like supermarkets etc that have kept us going, we owe then a massive debt of gratitude, I cannot thank them all individually but if you have a member who has been working throughout this pandemic please say thank you to them for your Brother Knights, I have asked for a Mass to be said "for all key workers intentions" as a thank you to them

Forms:

<u>SWC1</u>: The SWC1 been separated from the SW4a due to confidentiality problems experienced this year, there are two copies one is to be sent to Head Office and the Second to your Provincial Spirituality and Welfare Officer.

Please ensure that the correct form is used in the top right corner the year we are reporting on.

The first question **A** should read Total amount accounted for in the Council Benevolent Fund as of 1st April 2020:

<u>SW4a:</u> This form is for Head Office use only and <u>MUST NOT be sent to</u> PROVINCE.

This is for claiming special needs for the KSC year 2021/2022 and **must** be accompanied by the SWC1 (above), before any claim is processed.

It is important to remember that the names on this form are confidential and MUST NOT be spoken about by name at any level, the only Brothers who need to know the names are, the S&W officer/committee and finance Officer.

Reason for Claim: It is taken for granted that the Brother is suffering financial hardship, otherwise the council would not be requesting Special Needs Allowance, that said any form that give the reason as **Financial or Financial hardship**, will not be granted. What we do need is what is causing the financial hardship (remembering this information is treated with the strictest confidence).

The only part of the dues that are claimable on the SW4a is for Head Office dues only, which remains at £52 for the year 2021/22, it does not cover Council or Provincial dues.

If Council have been doing as I have asked them then they should know their Brothers, every Brother should have had 52 calls over the last year so we have had time to build the trust and friendship to speak to them about how they are coping physically, mentally and if they are in financial need.

Please note the Council must be in good standing when applying, please pay the invoice and deduct the amount you are claiming in Special Needs Allowance – should the claim be rejected then any outstanding amount can be settled later.

SW4: Application for a Grant: please use the form with 2021/2022 only. Again, this for is highly confidential and must be given a Council claim number for the year 2021/22 it should read 21 indicating the year and the

number of the claim for that year for example 01 for the first clime and 02 for the second and so on.

If a Brother is eligible for full knighthood but has not been elevated through no fault of his own then please indicate this on the form when applying

The reason for the claim must give a detailed account of why a grant is

The Brother must be in good standing (his dues have been paid to Head Office) before the application is made.

SW3; Notification of Death

This form must be submitted to Head Office ASAP following a death. An email/Phone call telling us of a death does not suffice, we must have the Form with all details filled-in.

On Saturday 12th June 2021 3pm, under current restrictions the numbers permitted to attend is be limited (at this time), therefore we have to book a place, this is done by emailing the names and contact number to welfare@ksc.org.uk

This does two things 1. Books a Place and 2. Cover's track and trace Once we have the names filling to capacity permitted the books will be closed, please do not have a wasted journey if you have not booked a place you will not be permitted entry, book now to save disappointment.

Please Note: All entering the cathedral must have their mask in place covering the mouth and nose before coming through the doors, and will be expected to sanitize their hands before taking their place as directed by a steward.

Stations of the Cross:

My thanks must go to those who have taken the lead and those who have done the responses I also thank all those who have been with us on the Monday evenings without you it would be pointless doing it, I also thank the Supreme Knight Brother Bertie O'Grogan and the Supreme Director for Media Brother Sean Smith for facilitating us on zoom.

It is always wonderful for our Brothers and family members to come together in unity to pray as one.
