

With the celebration of the birth of our Savior, Lord Jesus Christ, Anne and myself wish you and your families a happy and peaceful Christmas, may your family be blessed with joy and an abundance of love at this beautiful time in Our Churches year.

Fraternal Cross: Over the coming years the Fraternal Cross will again be going around the Order, along with this the Knights of St Columbanus (Ireland) presented our Order with a beautiful fraternal cross making our centenary, it is made of Irish Oak and beautifully carved, this will be accompanying the IACK fraternal Cross on it travels.

I hope to release dates in the January Bulletin, on a safety note the Irish Cross it is recommended that two Brothers work together when lifting and carrying it.

My plea to all Brothers is to take care of both crosses, as in 2019 when the IACK fraternal cross came back to Supreme Council minus it case, it was damaged as was the case when that arrived back, my gratitude to Brother John O'Donnell (PGK Province 1) who not only had it professionally repaired but at his own cost.

In 2019 I did have complaints in particular smaller and the larger Provinces that they either had it for too long or not long enough, in an effort to correct this I have emailed the Regional Directors asking how long they would want it for in their region. Further details in next month's bulletin.

Winter Care: As we are in the months of winter weather, where we will have cold, ice and snow, we must take care of our Brothers, Widows and Clergy many of who will fall into the older age bracket.

I encourage all Brothers and Councils please stay in regular contact with everybody connected to your council, ensure they are well, and in particular keeping warm, many older people are reluctant to put the heating on due to the cost, (I found my own father sitting with a coat on and blankets trying to stay warm so I know it happens because he was worried about the cost of heating) hypothermia is a killer, I would hate to find any of my Brother Knights, Widows or clergy dying because no one bothers to make a phone call.

Depression: We hear a lot about mental health these days far mor then in the past, one of the most common is depression, one common cause for depression particularly in the winter months is the long dark nights when loneliness sets in and the feeling that no one loves, cares or thinks about them, sending them into a downward spiral of depression.

Please Brothers let us ensure than nobody connected to our Order fells lonely, make that call 2 or 3 times a week if needed let them know they are loved, cared for and thought of by their Brother Knights let us all live up to our virtues of Charity, Unity and Fraternity.
